

What to do in Shanghai



Shanghai is a perfect fusion of tradition and modernity, where you can find both Yu Garden, built over 450 years ago, and Shanghai Tower, which now ranks as the second highest building in the world. We recommend the following attractions in case you want to spend more time here after the event, and we sincerely wish you a good time and a pleasant stay in Shanghai.

[1. The Bund of Shanghai](#)

The Bund of Shanghai is located on the East Bank of the Huangpu River. 52 classic buildings of Gothic and Baroque styles are to its west while Lujiazui, where modern skyscrapers stand, is opposite the Bund on the other side of the river; it is a good choice to enjoy the wonderful night view of bright neon lights in the Bund.

[2. Nanjing Road Pedestrian Street & People's Square](#)

Nanjing Road extends for 1,599 meters from Zhongshan East First Road in the east and Tibet Middle Road in the west. The section to the west of Henan Middle Road is well known as Nanjing Road Pedestrian Street which enjoys its reputation for being a major shopping centre and time-honoured street at the same time.

3. Top attractions near metro stations

On **Line 1**: Jinjiang Park, Xujiahui (shopping centre, old campus of SJTU), People's Square (People's Square and People's Park are not far away from the Bund, Nanjing Road.)

On **Line 2**: Zhongshan Park, Jing'an Temple, East (West) Nanjing Road (shopping streets and old-fashioned Shanghai buildings), Lujiazui (all amazing modern buildings including Oriental Pearl Tower), Shanghai Science and Technology Museum. Line 2 reaches most of the major scenic spots and famous hotels in Shanghai.
